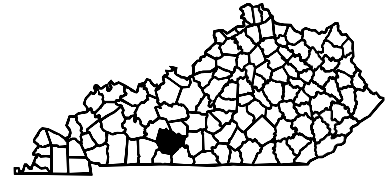

Admission requirements: ACT or SAT required for students below a 2.5 unweighted GPA. Students with a 2.5 or greater do not need to submit test scores for admission. All students must have at least a 2.0 unweighted GPA and a Composite Admission Index score of at least 60.

Spring: January 1
